For more than two years, the team in Mexico has adopted activities that give back and help the needlest community, through our volunteer Social Responsibility Committee, to carry out various projects with different focuses.

The Committee is made up of a multidisciplinary team from Archroma who contribute ideas, time and dedication to design and implement various campaigns aimed at the target segments of our communities.

Ideas/initiatives were presented to the Local Leadership Team (LLT) for approval, guidance and recommendations prior to implementation. The results and achievements were presented and validated by the LLT.

These efforts have given good results, thanks to the contribution of all Archorma employees who voluntarily are willing to collaborate in each Initiative.

The proposals were a success, and the participation of all colleagues makes this happen and the most important thing is that we managed to benefit those who require help.

During this fiscal year our 4 initiatives are:

Initiative #1: Victims of Ecatepec

After atypical rains in the Valley of Mexico, one of the most affected municipalities was Ecatepec de Morelos, a municipality in which the Santa Clara Plant operates; After 2 days of intense and continuous rains in the month of September 2021, landslides and floods were recorded that affected numerous families.

Faced with this situation, each of us contributed furniture, clothing and food for the affected families, including a cleaning specialist belonging to the Archroma family.



• Initiative #2: A gift to smile.

Thinking about the holiday season and being able to bring some happiness to the children of the Pediatric Hospital of Aragon, we organized a voluntary collection with winter clothes, sweets and toys.

• Initiative #3: Getting to know each other from a distance.

As part of the integration activities that we promote in the Committee, we seek an opportunity for the team in Mexico to meet different co-workers, beyond the work environment with whom they usually do not have contact. This initiative was replicated in the LATAM region and was adopted adapted as the "Latin Women's Forum".

• Initiative #4: Earth Day / Children's Day.

This project in a phase aimed at collaborators to contribute and raise awareness by supporting in various ways the care of the environment in the company of their families and on the other hand contributing with groceries, toys and sweets to celebrate their day with the children of the home in Celaya near to Salvatierra and in the Pediatric Hospital of Aragon.
